Impact

During the first two terms in Nursery, the key focus for the pupil premium children was ensuring that they had a free school meal, this was paid for using PP money. We also supported the children at lunchtime to ensure that they developed good eating habits, through staffing using an extra adult in the hall. The children accessed a physical intervention to develop fine motor skills and early phonics.

We cannot look at the impact from these interventions as the year was cut short due to COVID. There has also been an underspend of the pupil premium money. We received a total of £5660.93 and we spent £3020 which means there was a surplus of £2640.93. This money needs to be used to ensure that the pupil premium children in Reception get appropriate catch up

intervention and this will be primarily in speech and language. The extra intervention therefore will be for speech initiatives such as the LLLI in Nursery and Neli in Reception. It will be used alongside the COVID funding strategy money; our report shows that part of this grant is being used to fund a speech and language therapist which will ensure that speech and language problems will be looked at early and not rely on parents taking the children for appointments.
